NEW PLAYGROUNDS AND SPORTS PAVILION FOR YARRA RANGES

More opportunities to get active are on the way for Yarra Ranges residents thanks to a major new investment from the Andrews Labor Government.

Local Government Minister Adem Somyurek has today announced that four Yarra Ranges projects are among 32 successful projects which will receive funding from the latest round of the Growing Suburbs Fund.

The Fund is delivering \$50 million towards community facilities, enhanced services and greater opportunities in Melbourne's 10 rapidly growing interface councils.

The four Yarra Ranges Shire Council projects receiving a share of \$3.5 million are:

- Belgrave Lake Park – \$600,000 towards an upgrade of the park, including an expanded playground.
- Elizabeth Bridge Reserve – \$700,000 towards the first stage of a major facilities upgrade.
- Mount Evelyn Community Sport and Recreation Pavilion – \$1.9 million towards a new purpose-built multi-purpose complex and community pavilion for Mount Evelyn, supporting the development and growth of female participation in sport.
- Monbulk Recreation Reserve Skate and Scooter Park Upgrade – \$300,000 towards expanding and enhancing the skate park facilities.

This investment takes the total Growing Suburbs Fund commitment to Yarra Ranges Shire Council to \$20.5 million for 19 projects over the last five years.

Across greater Melbourne, the Fund has now supported 193 projects, invested \$250 million and leveraged a combined investment of \$665 million, creating more than 6750 jobs.
